THE HEADS OF STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCs); THE REGIONAL DIRECTORS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT (DBM) AND THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHED); AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT

SUC LEVELING INSTRUMENT AND GUIDELINES FOR

THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF

- 1.0. This circular is issued to amend Section IV, Item A.2 (Key Result Areas) of DBM-CHED Joint Circular No. 1-A, s. 2003 dated October 24, 2003, providing for the SUC Leveling Instrument and Guidelines for the Implementation Thereof.
- 2.0. Item A.2 thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

A.2 Key Result Areas

The four (4) Key Result Areas (KRAs) represent the major indicators that would measure the stages of development and institutional performance of the respective SUCs.

The level of the SUC shall be based on the total point scores earned/obtained by the institution in the four (4) Key Result Areas (KRAs) as follows:

- Level IV ----28-35 points
- Level III ----20-27 points
- Level II ----11-19 points
- Level I ----below 11 points

Provided that to obtain Level IV, the SUC must meet the minimum points for KRA A (14 points) and KRA B (6 points) for Level IV.

Provided further that to obtain Level III-A, the SUC must meet the minimum points for KRA A (10 points) for Level III-A and to obtain Level III-B, the SUC must obtain the minimum points for KRA B (6 points) for Level III-B.

- 3.0. The incremental Personal Services requirements, as result of this amendment, will be charged against the income/savings of the respective SUCs subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4.0. This Circular shall take effect immediately.
