

NEW PROGRAMS"

In line with the recommendations of the Technical Panel for Engineering, Architecture and Maritime Education (TPEAME), the engineering and architecture undergraduate programs are hereby included in the list of courses that will be covered by the moratorium on the opening of new programs under section 3.0 of CHED Order No. 2, s. 1995.
2. In view of this, all applications to open the above-mentioned programs that are already in the pipeline shall be evaluated based on the existing standard and on the new procedures provided under CHED Order No. 2, s. 1995. Applications received after April 30, 1995 shall not be given due course.
3. This Order shall take effect immediately.

TECHNICAL PANEL FOR ENGINEERING, ARCHITECTURE AND
MARITIME EDUCATION**

February 17, 1995 at the
3rd Floor, National Engineering Center
UP Diliman, Quezon City

RESOLUTION NO. 1

Including the Engineering and Architecture undergraduate programs in the list of courses that will be covered by the moratorium on the opening of new programs.

WHEREAS, Section 3.0 of CHED ORDER NO.2, s.1995 entitled IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE OPENING OF NEW PROGRAMS states that only nursing, medicine, other health-related courses and maritime education are exempted from this Order and shall be covered by the existing moratorium.

WHEREAS, There are already more or less a total of 188 engineering and 49 architecture programs all over the country, EXCLUDING courses which are operating without a permit or have just acquired their permit from the CHED Higher Education Regional Offices.

WHEREAS, There is an urgent need to include the engineering and architecture programs in the moratorium on the opening of new courses due to cited cases of indiscriminate issuances of permit to operate engineering courses in the CHED Higher Education Regional Offices level.

WHEREAS, There is still no indicative national plan/policy for higher education HRD development, and the deluge of new offerings could pre-empt such policies/plans.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as it is hereby resolved that the Engineering and Architecture undergraduate programs be covered by the existing moratorium and henceforth, be included in the list of courses that will be exempted from CHED ORDER NO. 2, s.1995.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that all applications already in the pipeline at the time of the approval of the moratorium contemplated herein shall be evaluated based on existing standard and on the new procedures.


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the addendum to the said Order be effective upon the approval of the Commissioners, and be immediately disseminated to colleges and universities.

Unanimously adopted and approved during the 2nd panel meeting held on February 17, 1995.
